## SO LET ME TELL YOU ABOUT THE NEW "SMARTCARD"

The Smartcard is a new pay-as-you-go travel card which allows passengers to pay for their bus travel without having to scrabble around for change (Uh – Genius!?).

The smartcard closely resembles the capital's Oyster card in that it can be topped up online, at certain libraries or in person on the bus. There's also the ability to set up an "auto top-up", meaning that if the bill payer forgets, the card will have done it, and the user will always have credit!

Nu-Venture, Autocar, Chalkwell, ASD, Farleight and Go-Coach have been quick to snap up the smartcards as a form of quick and easy payments on their buses. Looking forward, Kent County Council wants to see a smartcard which can be expanded to include train journeys, bike hire, car hire and allow folks an easy door-to-door journey whether that be for work or, as in this case, for the school run!

In my opinion there is an obvious benefit for the parents whose children have access to these bus routes, who may feel reassured to know that come what may, their child has a failsafe, should they get held up, if their child has a smart card with a basic amount of credit. The smartcard also provides a solution to other common concerns - some parents would love for their child to travel to school by bus, but are concerned about them carrying cash...or buying sweets with the bus money!? Not only this but as a family, this card can be passed about to multiple users – it is not limited to just one named traveller!
