APPLY FOR CAPITAL GRANT FUNDING

Great news - the window for the 2017-18 Capital Grant Funding applications is now open!! All Kent schools can apply for a grant of up to £5k in order to support and promote active and sustainable travel choices. The infrastructure could be anything that encourages pupils and parents to travel to/from school in a way that reduces the number of cars used for the school run.

For example, St Joseph's Catholic Primary School in Broadstairs understood that parents were less inclined to walk with their children due to having no shelter to wait under on those days when the weather was dismal or particularly hot. So, with their successful bid for funding they were able to install a canopy which not only looks fabulous but has also enormously impacted the on the amount of parents now willing to walk to the school, knowing that they can take cover, should the wonderful English weather live up to its unpredictable nature.

To apply, all you will need to do is complete an annual review via the Jambusters system and enter your grant bid details upon completion. You will need to submit your review and grant application, no later than 5pm, on Friday 9th June. Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified no later than Friday 14th July.

Remember, you can be as creative as you like with your application! Innovative ideas will be looked upon favourably (see Page2 for more ideas!). You can even apply with match funding for bids under and above £5k. You can find a full run down of the Application Guidance on the Jambusters site, within the FAQ's - Grant Application tab.
